

Accreditation and International Recognition



The European Humanities University is the only non-state establishment of higher education in Belarus that has a state recognized university status. Following the attestation inspection in 1998, the Belarusian Ministry of Education reconfirmed this status. The final inspection document sets

forward that the EHU “meets [national] requirements for university-type establishments of higher education.” In 1999-2001, eleven EHU's major programs were certified and officially accredited by the Belarusian Ministry of Education.
