The Department's difference from law schools of other Belarusian universities manifests itself in its striving to master European and American legal traditions; advanced-level study of international and European law; comparative character of teaching a series of legal disciplines; active collaboration with foreign colleagues on the exchange of educational technologies; a combination of professional training and intensive foreign language learning; and a mastery of the new legal disciplines not traditional for the state legal education system.

The EHU was the first institution in the Republic of Belarus to set up a pilot project on Legal Assistance Clinic. Under the supervision of lawyers the fourth-year law students involved in this project provide free legal consultations.

On the basis of the international cooperation the EHU maintains the tradition of studying European Law first started with the TEMPUS project in collaboration with Bordeaux-IV University (France) and University of Alcalá de Henares (Spain). The EHU students are offered a minor program in the International Economic Law, run jointly with the support of the German International Foundation for Legal Cooperation. It has become a tradition for the EHU senior students to take part in the international law competitions such as the International Law Moot Court Competition, the European Law Moot Court Competition, Concurs Jean-Pictet.
